JACK CAMPBELL, State Attorney for the Second Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, charges that in LEON County, Florida, the above-named defendant(s):

COUNT I: On or about April 15, 2017, did unlawfully drive or was in actual physical control of a vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance pursuant Section 877.111, or any substance controlled under Chapter 893, Florida Statutes, while affected to the extent that his or her normal faculties were impaired, or had a blood-alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood; or had a breath-alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath, and by reason of such operation caused or contributed to causing damage to the property or person of Gregory Bontz, contrary to Section 316.193(3)(c)1, Florida Statutes.

COUNT II: On or about April 15, 2017, did then and there drive a motor vehicle which was involved in a crash resulting in damage to a vehicle or other property being driven or attended by Gregory Bontz, and thereafter failed to stop and remain at the scene of the crash until said defendant had fulfilled the requirements of Section 316.062, knowing or under such circumstances that he/she should have known that he/she was involved in the crash, contrary to Section 316.061, Florida Statutes.
