**JOINT MOTION FOR STAY OF APPEAL**

The parties jointly move for a 30 day stay of this appeal on the following grounds:

1. The Lottery filed an unopposed motion to extend the filing date for its initial brief. The motion was granted, resulting in a new filing date of July 7, 2017. The ground for the motion was that the Secretary of the Lottery had resigned effective June 2, 2017, and the Lottery desired to give the new secretary an opportunity to review the case and approve the brief prior to filing.
2. A new Secretary has been appointed and will assume his official duties on July 10, 2017. The parties are now engaged in good faith negotiations in an attempt to resolve this dispute, and believe that the likelihood of achieving a

satisfactory resolution will be enhanced if they do not have to solidify their positions by filing briefs during negotiations.
